

HEAD START is a federally funded program that serves low-income families.

Families who receive TANF, SSI or are determined homeless are eligible. Priority is given to families who are at or below the Federal Poverty Guidelines that are released each year by the Federal Government.

Early Head Start Home Base Program



What is EHS Home Base?

A family and child development program provided through weekly home visits in your home.

Fun play group experiences for infants and toddlers and their parents (Twice a month).

Pregnant women support groups

Early support services to help you meet your goals for a healthy pregnancy and build a nurturing parent child relationship and healthy development of your infant/toddler.



Head Start

Classrooms are located throughout Napa and Solano Counties.

Center based child development centers are a Part Day/Part Year program offering:

- Highly qualified, trained staff
- Well-equipped classrooms
- Individualized teaching
- Nutritious snacks & meals
- Health screenings
- Parent Involvement opportunities



A child is considered age eligible if he or she turns 3 or 4 years old by the school district cutoff each program year. Priority will be given to a four year old.

- Classes are Monday through Thursday
- Morning and afternoon sessions
- 3.5 or 4 hours each day
- September to June

Early Head Start & Head Start Full Day

To be considered eligible for full day, child and family must show a special need that justifies full day services or parent/guardians need to be employed or enrolled in a job training program or attending school with no caregiver present in the home.

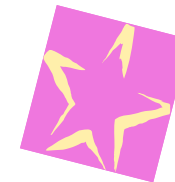
Families that are determined eligible for the Therapeutic Child Care Center have additional selection criteria.

EHS Toddler centers serve children ages 18-30 months.

At the Therapeutic Child Care Center, in Napa, we serve infants and toddlers up to 30 months.

Full Day Head Start Preschool centers serve children ages three or four years of age. Child must turn 3 or 4 by the cutoff used by the local school district.

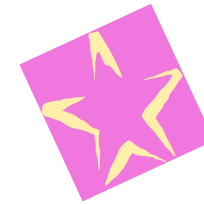
