#### Celebrating the 1965 Civil Rights Act and Head Start Impacts.

During the month of February, we honor Black History across the country, and acknowledge how Head Start played a role to help fight discrimination and segregation in the Deep South.

For decades, African-Americans faced hostility in education and disparity in funding between white and black schools. It was the federal Economic Opportunity Act of 1964 that promoted anti-poverty programs, ultimately paving the way for Head Start to begin its work of preparing low-income children for school.

In the mid-1960s, Head Start Programs in Mississippi helped inspire new political movements that gave light to the racial struggles occurring throughout the civil-rights movement. Without their work, bravery and advocacy, we would not be the premier program that we are today – one that is highly recognized and respected across American institutions and party lines.

As we celebrate Black History month, Child Start joins other Head Start organizations across the country in recognizing and acknowledging the important contributions that many African-Americans have made, and continue to make, in the fight for equitable opportunities for everyone.


