
The Power button is located on top of the unit (blue light on the left of the unit will indicate if it's on) and should be on when you get to your site on.

5 Ways Hackers Use Public Wi-Fi to Steal Your Identity

Love using public Wi-Fi? So do hackers!

Learn how cybercriminals can access your private data while you use public Wi-Fi.

We've all used public Wi-Fi: it's free, saves on your data allowance, and is always helpful in speeding up loading times.

Shoulder Surfing



This might seem obvious, but we often forget these sort of simple security measures.

Whenever using an ATM, you should check those around you, making sure no one's peeking as you enter your PIN.

It's also a danger when it comes to public Wi-Fi. If someone is hovering around when you're visiting private sites, be suspicious. Don't submit anything personal like a password. It's a very basic scam, but one that certainly still works for hustlers and hackers.

A "shoulder surfer" might not even need to be behind you: just watching what you type can give criminals something to work with.

How to Protect Against Shoulder Surfers


Be vigilant. Know who's around you. Sometimes, paranoia can help. If you're not sure of those around you, don't go on anything private.

Don't underestimate the importance of what you're filling out or reading either: medical information can be useful to identity thieves, for example. If it's a document or webpage you wouldn't want anybody else seeing, take precautions to stop that from happening.

Another option is to purchase a privacy screen; these limit what people see on your screen.
