Strategies to Support and Engage Families Virtually

Effective family engagement involves using virtual communication tools and strategies to build relationships with parents, families, and caregivers and work with them to achieve their families' goals. These tools and strategies should be equitable, inclusive, and culturally and linguistically responsive. Virtual communication tools include text, phone, video conferencing, online chat, apps, websites, email, and social media.

Head Start and Early Head Start family services staff have used various virtual options and strategies to provide services and support for children and families. Staff can use this resource to build on their existing knowledge, expertise, and resources for developing positive and goal-oriented relationships with families.

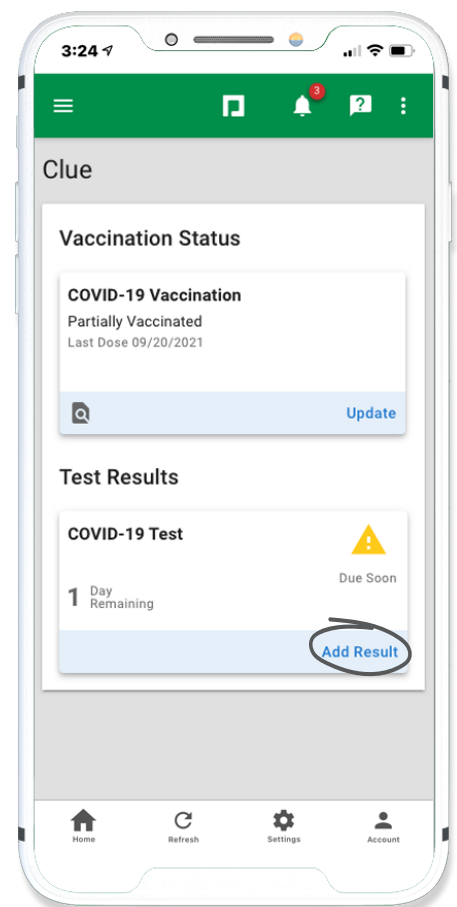
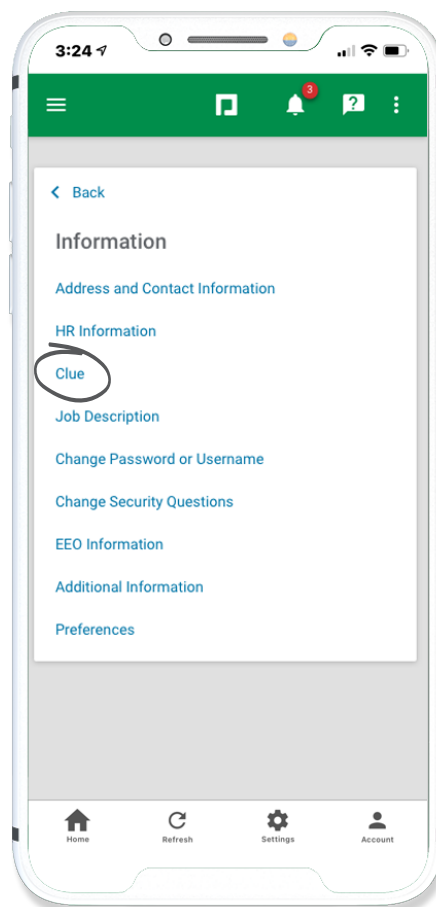
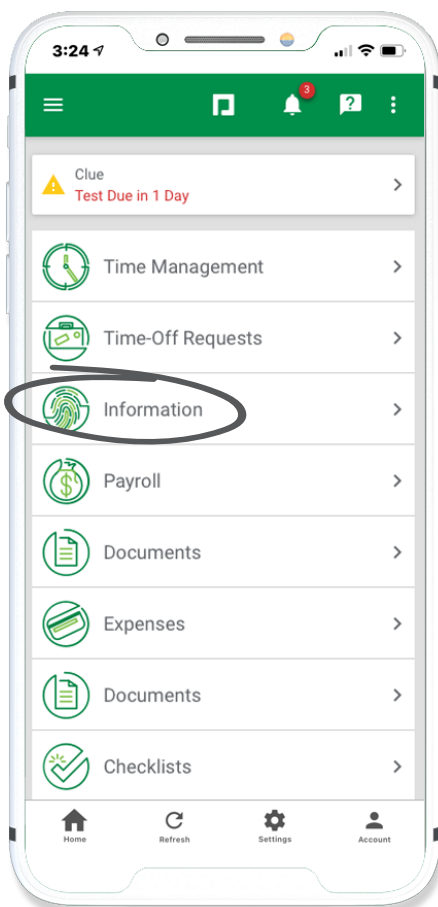


STEP 1

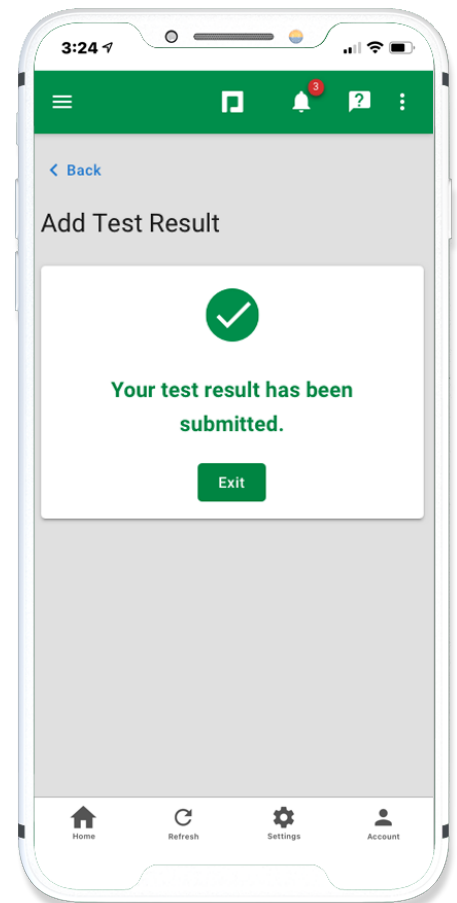
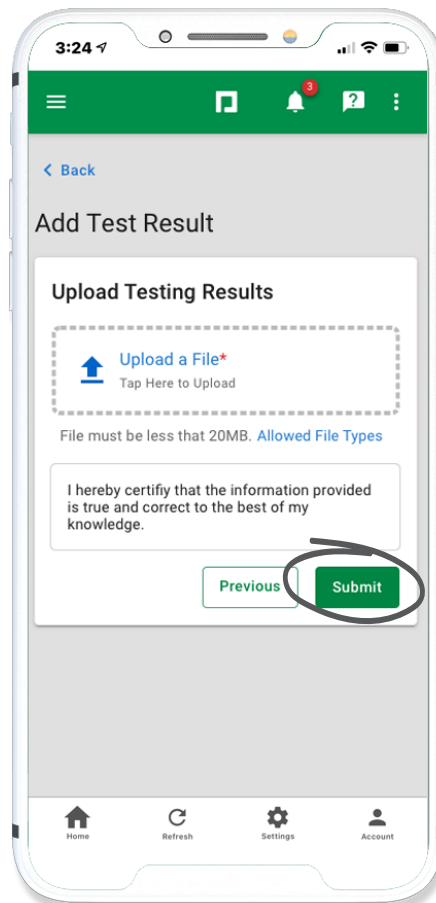
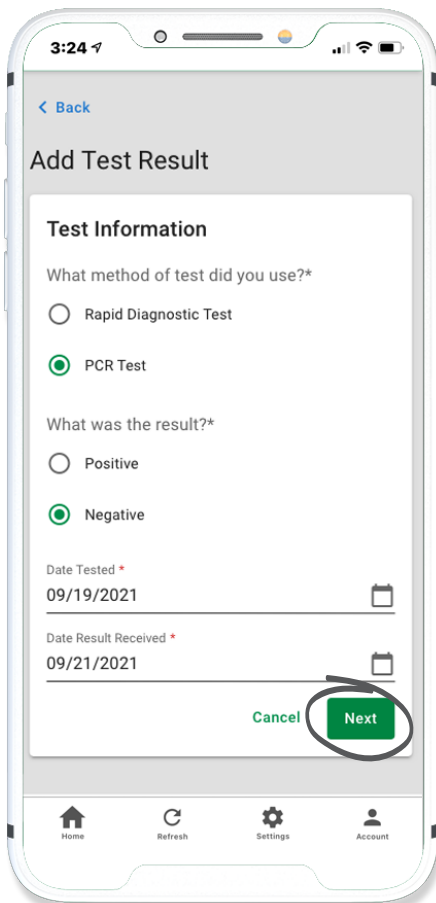


STEP 2
