I am grateful Head Start was an available option for my mom. It turned out to be a good decision for both of us. 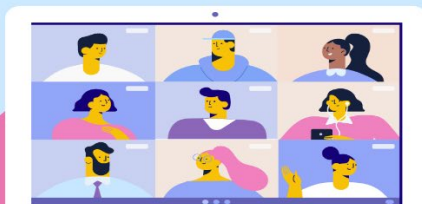
