



Head Start Services as a Maternal Health Intervention

This webinar explores how Head Start services can intentionally function as a health equity intervention that can contribute to closing racial disparities that are fuelled by inequitable access to resources and positive experiences. One of those critical disparities is maternal and infant birth outcomes. American Indian, Alaska Native, and Black people are two to three times more likely to die of pregnancy-related causes than white people. This webinar will introduce participants to maternal health resources developed for Head Start staff. It will also provide staff with potential modes of support for pregnant people and their families.
