Head Start Awareness Month is observed during the Month of October. It has been observed since October 22,1982 when President Ronald Reagan proclaimed it. The Head Start Program itself was created by President Lyndon B. Johnson in 1964 as a project designed to break the cycle of poverty with the focus on providing comprehensive health, nutrition, and educational opportunities for children and families across the United States.

Tips for filming a successful video:

We hope these videos will be candid conversations with Head Start teachers, parents, and staff. No preparation or fancy camera setups are necessary!


- Place your camera or phone at eye level so you are looking into it directly. Propping the camera or phone up on books may be helpful. If you are recording on a phone, place it on a stable surface (don't hold it in your hand!)
- Ideally, choose a quiet space with natural light. The best lighting is when you are facing the light source (sitting in front of a window is usually great!)
- Frame yourself in the center of the video, facing the camera directly.

If you are including a parent and child, they can sit on their lap or reposition the camera or phone at a lower height to capture their face. (Media Release consent will be requested before publication).

EXTREMELY IMPORTANT EMAIL SECURITY ALERT!

Just another reminder to please be very careful with your email correspondence and always be on the lookout for *phishing emails* that may happen to land in your Inbox. I appreciate the Child Start staff member who submitted this to IT and for being vigilant and immediately suspecting that the email message to *not* be **legitimate**.

Here is a screenshot of the email message "supposedly" sent by a *Child Start employee*:

Some questions to ask yourself:

The sender's email address, rightbox@mail.com should immediately raise a flag that this is a suspicious email.

- Why didn't this Child Start employee use their Child Start email address (account) OR why did they use an email address that doesn't readily identify her or him?
- Does the email require action on my part?
 - especially if the action involves sending and providing sensitive information to the sender (i.e., Social Security numbers, Employee and/or Payroll IDs, etc.,
 - o a request to change personnel information on file

Now if the email address showed an email address that followed Child Start's naming convention (first name initial, last name) but *had a domain name other than @childstartinc.org* (e.g., if the employee's name is John Doe, the email address would be *idoe@childstartinc.org* but the email you received had *idoe@gmail.com* as the email address), you should *send a NEW email message* to the sender *with their Child Start email address* to verify the validity of the email you had received – **DO NOT REPLY BACK TO THE SUSPICIOUS EMAIL.**

Please refrain from "Replying-to-All" and direct any questions/concerns to myself or the IT Helpdesk.


Coping with Grief & Loss

FLU & COVID-19 VACCINES FAQ'S

YOU MATTER! PROTECT YOURSELF AND OTHERS THIS FLU SEASON!

COVID-19 AND INFLUENZA SYMPTOMS ARE VERY SIMILAR. HERE ARE A FEW THINGS YOU CAN DO TO PROTECT YOURSELF AND PREVENT THE SPREAD OF DISEASE:

- WEAR A MASK WITH GOOD FILTRATION (SURGICAL GRADE, N95 OR KN95)
- GET TESTED FOR COVID-19 IF YOU HAVE SYMPTOMS OR HAVE BEEN EXPOSED
- STAY HOME IF YOU ARE SICK
- GET YOUR FLU AND COVID-19 VACCINES AS SOON AS POSSIBLE

WHEN IS IT THE RIGHT TIME TO GET THE FLU VACCINE?

SEPTEMBER AND OCTOBER ARE GOOD TIMES TO GET VACCINATED. HOWEVER, AS LONG AS FLU VIRUSES ARE CIRCULATING, VACCINATION SHOULD CONTINUE, EVEN INTO JANUARY OR LATER.

WHY DO WE
RECOMMEND FLU
AND
COVID-19
VACCINES?

GETTING VACCINATED FOR BOTH THE FLU AND COVID WILL ENSURE THAT A PERSON WILL BE PROTECTED AGAINST SEVERE ILLNESS, HOSPITALIZATION AND DEATH FROM COVID-19 AND THE FLU VACCINE CAN HELP SOMEONE FROM GETTING PNEUMONIA OR BRONCHITIS. GETTING SICK DURING A PANDEMIC IS SERIOUS AND CAN BE PREVENTED. YOU MATTER, PROTECT YOURSELF AND YOUR COMMUNITY!

IS IT OKAY TO GET THE COVID-19 VACCINE WITH OTHER VACCINES (IN ADDITION TO COVID/FLU)? YOU CAN GET A COVID-19 VACCINE AND OTHER VACCINES AT THE SAME VISIT. WHAT STUDIES SHOW ABOUT HOW OUR BODIES DEVELOP PROTECTION AFTER GETTING VACCINATED IS THAT THE IMMUNE RESPONSE IS THE SAME WHETHER YOU GET ONE VACCINE OR MULTIPLE VACCINES AT THE SAME TIME.

WHAT CAN I EXPECT IF I GET BOTH THE FLU AND COVID VACCINES IN ONE DAY?

IF MULTIPLE VACCINES ARE ADMINISTERED AT A SINGLE VISIT, IT CAN BE EXPECTED THAT EACH INJECTION WILL BE ADMINISTERED IN A DIFFERENT PART OF THE BODY. YOU CAN ALSO EXPECT THE SAME DEGREE OF SIDE EFFECTS AS IF YOU HAD GOTTEN ONLY ONE VACCINATION.
